Sawyer: Climbing and cooking fajitas.

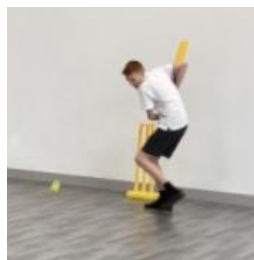
Thomas: spending time with people I like.
