In **art**, creating sea creatures from recycled materials like plastic bottle fish and paper plate jellyfish has been a highlight. These creations have contributed to a wonderful under-the-sea-themed display in our classroom. We have also continued our upcycling chair project with the rest of the Tudor team.

In **cooking**, we developed our safety skills and confidence in using the hob to make pancakes.
